Madison Public Library Receives National Grant for Small and Rural Libraries

April 10, 2025 (Madison, SD) – Madison Public Library has been selected as one of 300 libraries to participate in round three of Libraries Transforming Communities: Accessible Small and Rural Communities, an American Library Association (ALA) initiative that provides community engagement and accessibility resources to small and rural libraries to help them better serve people with disabilities.

The competitive award comes with a \$10,000 grant that will help the library improve the entrance doorway to ensure safer, more comfortable access for patrons with mobility challenges, as well as caregivers and parents with strollers. This renovation will address the current limitations of the narrow doorway, which can pose difficulties and safety concerns, and will move us closer to our goal of creating a fully accessible and welcoming library for all.

"We are so proud to be chosen again for this amazing opportunity," said Systems Librarian, Melanie Argo. "This third round of funding provides our library with an additional grant to help us continue what we started with our Round 2 Ramp project, set to be done in the near future."

As part of the grant, Madison Public library staff will host a conversation with residents about physical accessibility to the library and use the grant funds to improve the entrance doorway.
